“National Trends in Healthcare” Topic for Columbus Association of Health Underwriters February Meeting

Columbus (January 25, 2008) – “National Trends in Healthcare” will be the topic of a program (1 insurance CE credit) offered by the Columbus Association of Health Underwriters (CAHU) at their monthly meeting on Tuesday, February 12, 2008 at Confluence Park Restaurant, 679 Spring Street, Columbus. The meeting, which is open to the public, is sponsored by Anthem. Registration and a lunch buffet will begin at 11:30 AM and will be followed by the 1-hour course at 12:30 PM.

Course instruction will be led by Jennifer M. Bollinger. This course provides statistics about the Nation’s health care environment, reviewing historical trends along with future expectations. The course is divided into five topical areas: demographic trends, health risk and status, costs and expenditures, employer benefit benchmarks, and emerging trends. Each section provides statistics from a variety of credible sources, along with information on how these changes affect the health care delivery system.
