## **Policy:**

By NABIP By-laws, NABIP Ohio past presidents may serve as a voting delegate to the NABIP National Convention, representing either the State Association or any local association within the state. If attendees to the NABIP Convention from Ohio are less than the allowed amount per NABIP By-Laws, NABIP Ohio Past Presidents will be eligible to attend the convention as a voting delegate. Under these circumstances, NABIP Ohio will provide some financial support to these attendees.

## **Procedure:**

- 1. NABIP Ohio Past Presidents interested in attending the NABIP Convention should contact the NABIP Ohio President for permission and board approval.
- 2. Once delegates from NABIP Ohio and the locals are determined, if additional delegates are needed, the requesting past presidents will be notified of the availability as a voting delegate.
- 3. If approved, these individuals will be responsible for filing an NABIP Ohio expense report for reimbursement within the timeframe as outlined in the NABIP Ohio Expense Reimbursement Board/Leg Policy 2008 0301.
- 4. Need to be a member in good standing and you need to attend all functions at convention as any other attendee.
